STAR NEWS 14 April 2024

This Sunday we see another appearance of Jesus to the Disciples after the Resurrection. The post-resurrection appearances of Jesus recorded in the four gospels have a common purpose: to prepare the faithful for life in the world as witnesses to the resurrection and representatives of the continuing presence of Jesus, our Lord.

The theme of today's readings is the challenge to adjust our lives to the living presence of the risen Lord as we grow daily more aware of the presence of His

Holy Spirit within us and surrounding us. This awareness should strengthen our hope in His promises, bring us to true repentance for our sins and the renewal of our lives, and lead us to bear witness to Christ through our works of charity. The readings also remind us that the purpose of the suffering, death, and Resurrection of Jesus was to save us from our sins. Here is a story told about a recent convert to the Christian faith who was asked by one of his unbelieving friends about Jesus.

The friend said to him: "I hear you have become a Christian." "Yes," said the convert. "Then you must know a great deal about Christ," said the friend, "tell me, what country was he born in?" "I don't know," replied the convert.

"Well, can you tell me how many sermons he preached? Or how he was born, or how he did miracles, or how he was raised from the dead?" asked the friend.

"I don't know", responded the convert.

"You certainly know very little for a man who claims to be a Christian," said the friend. "You are right," replied the convert, "I am ashamed of how little I know- but this much I do know. Three years ago, I was a drunkard. I was in debt. My family was failing to pieces. My wife and children would dream of my return home each evening. I was desperate. I gave my heart to God. Now I have given up booze, we are out of debt, and my wife and I are in love once more. All this Christ has done for me. This much I know.

In our journey through life, we are confronted with several problems and difficulties which can make us lose our perspective. We can lose all direction to life and remain helpless. Then left to ourselves we become nothing and tend to remain with uncertainty. In such situations, we need positive support and a sincere understanding which can place us on the right path. In the Easter context, we see Jesus as a consoler and help to the disciples filled with fear. He comes constantly to them and remains with them, guides them and eats with them. By breaking the bread with the disciples and sharing the meal he makes them experience his real presence. Today we have another account of Jesus appearing to his disciples on Easter Sunday. The gospel begins with the story of the two disciples who had the experience of walking with Jesus and their recognition of the Lord in the breaking of bread. Jesus remaining close to them drives away all their doubts and unbelief by giving them peace. He asks the disciples to touch and feel him and experience his real presence among them. He remains the real friend in their lives and helps them back into confidence. How often do we experience the presence of Risen Christ in our lives? Are we grateful for the blessings and changes he brings to us?
